

ServiceHunter AG Announces Leadership Transition and Reinforces Path to Global Fair Employment

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Lad Beuzelin & David Christen, the new leadership team of ServiceHunter AG.

- **Marie-Christin Kamann steps down as CEO** after nearly a decade leading ServiceHunter AG, provider of automated payroll solutions **quitt** and **quitt Business**. At the same time, **Arman Margaryan also departs from his role as CTO**, together having rebuilt the company's operational and technological foundation and laid the groundwork for international growth. They will remain closely engaged until the end of 2026, ensuring a seamless transition and focused handover.
- **David Christen, founder and current CMO of ServiceHunter AG, steps in as CEO**, while **Lad Beuzelin, CEO of the acquired Earny SA, joins as COO**. Both roles took effect on 1 July 2026 and together, they form a lean, founder-aligned leadership team built for the next phase of international growth.
- **Guillaume Dubray, CEO of Polytech Ventures, joins the Board of Directors**, elected during the company's general assembly.

ServiceHunter AG announced a leadership transition that marks the completion of one chapter and the confident start of the next. Almost ten years ago, Marie-Christin Kamann and Arman Margaryan joined the company with a clear and demanding brief: to rebuild ServiceHunter AG from the ground up and make it ready to scale internationally.

The company today serves over 40'000 private households and operates across Switzerland, Germany, and the UK. Having achieved that, they now hand the stage to the next leadership team to carry the expansion forward.

David Christen, founder and current CMO of ServiceHunter AG, assumes the role of CEO, taking direct responsibility for strategy, product direction, and international growth. Lad Beuzelin joins as COO, overseeing operations and execution as the company scales. They take over a company that is operationally established and ready to accelerate, a transition made with full alignment and a shared understanding of what the next stage of growth requires. As part of that next stage, the Swiss-based engineering team is being strengthened as a strategic priority, with active plans to grow headcount and deepen product capabilities.

At the company's general assembly, Guillaume Dubray, CEO of Polytech Ventures, joined the Board of Directors, while Béla von Mérey from Cape Capital was elected as Board President. Guillaume Dubray brings additional expertise in venture investment and strategic scaling, strengthening the board's capacity to guide ServiceHunter AG through its next phase of international growth.

A new distributed leadership structure is also established alongside David Christen and Lad Beuzelin across countries: Samira Aleotti (Switzerland), Lena Ardelt (Germany), and Philip Norman (UK).

The purpose at the heart of that ambition has not changed: **fair employment, for all.**
