### quitt launches in Ticino on 12.12.2024: Digital solutions for legal and fair labour relations now also in southern Switzerland.

Zürich, 12.12.2025 – [quitt](#) expands into Ticino. From now on, private employers in Italian-speaking Switzerland will also be able to hire domestic help quickly, easily and in compliance with the law. The expansion is a further step towards [quitt](#)'s vision of combating undeclared work in private households and promoting fair working conditions. Both employers and employees will benefit, especially in the canton of Ticino, where the rate of undeclared work is believed to be high and the wages for domestic workers are among the lowest in Switzerland. With partners such as Zurich Insurance, Helsana, TCS Assista, Nest Fondation collective, Valitas AG and ETH Zurich, [quitt](#) relies on strong co-operations to offer its customers comprehensive solutions.

In 2023, Ticino carried out 2,340 company inspections to combat undeclared work (according to the BGSA 2023 report), which represents 17% of all inspections in Switzerland. With an inspection density of 571 company inspections per 10,000 workplaces - the highest in Switzerland - it can be assumed that undeclared work is

more widespread in Ticino than average. In addition, the average hourly wage for domestic workers is CHF 26.80, well below the national average of CHF 30.77, reflecting the region's economic disadvantage. This combination of low wages and high levels of undeclared work exacerbates economic challenges.

Due to the high administrative requirements for the correct employment of domestic help, undeclared work in private households is widespread in Ticino. **quitt** simplifies and digitalises the entire employment process - from registering with social insurance companies to monthly payroll accounting. Employers benefit from a legally compliant, time-saving and cost-efficient service that eliminates bureaucratic hurdles. **'Many people want to employ domestic help correctly, but the high administrative burden is a deterrent. **quitt** creates a simple solution and promotes fair working conditions - which is particularly important in an economically challenged region like Ticino,'** explains Marie-Christin Kamann, CEO of **quitt**.

[Employees also benefit](#): Compared to cleaning companies, employees receive on average 50% more pay at CHF 10 less cost per hour for the employer because there is no intermediary between employees and employers. As part of its expansion, **quitt** is cooperating with Zurich Insurance. This partnership enables customers to offer comprehensive insurance services.

In addition, **quitt** is expanding its range of services: with 'quitt Business', all companies can now process their wages and social security contributions via the platform. Previously, this service was only available to start-ups. Besides this **quitt** is the market leader in Switzerland and backs up this position with impressive figures: Since 2011, **quitt** has counted over 30,000 customers to date and a settled payroll of over CHF 450 million. Over 10,000 active jobs and more than CHF 100 million in volume in 2024 alone. **quitt** successfully launched in Germany and is looking to expand to the United Kingdom and Austria. **'Our vision is a world without undeclared work, where fair and transparent working conditions are the standard,'** adds Marie-Christin Kamann, CEO of **quitt**.
